Rental assistance through the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is available for some apartments at Cedar Lane Senior Living Community. Subsidized rent is calculated based on your specific income, assets and medical expenses. **If you qualify for HUD subsidized rent, you will pay approximately 30% of your adjusted monthly income as your rent.** The remainder of the contract rent is paid by HUD. Rental assistance is offered on select apartments in Building I, and most apartments in Building II. Income limits apply. There are no rental subsidies available in Building III, and therefore there is no income limit.
